Prayer is for grant of anticipatory bail in case having FIR No.48 dated 28.6.2022 registered under Section 379 IPC and Sections 21(1) and 4(1) of Mines and Mineral (Regulations of Development) Act at Police Station Chamkaur Sahib District Rupnagar.

As per the allegations recorded in the FIR, the accused persons illegally excavated soil from the disclosed place owned by Gram Panchayat of the village; and Gaganpreet Singh and Davinder Singh were apprehended at the spot along with poclain machine, one tipper and one tractor, which were used for illegal excavation of soil from the '*Panchayati*' land.

On the last date of hearing, interim bail with detailed order with further direction to the petitioners was passed to join investigation with the police.

Today, counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners have joined investigation with the police by virtue of previous order of interim bail passed by this Court.

State counsel on instructions from ASI Sohan Lal submits that the petitioners have joined investigation with the police and the recoveries are already effected in this case and further submits that the petitioners are not required by police for further investigation or for custodial interrogation.

In view of the above, without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is hereby allowed and order dated 12.09.2022 is hereby made absolute. The petitioners should abide by the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
