1. The instant petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. with a prayer to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.107 dated 23.12.2019, registered under Sections 15, 25, 61, 85 of NDPS Act, 1985, at Police Station Jodhan, District Ludhiana.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of the order dated 11.08.2023 passed by this Court, the petitioner has surrendered before the trial Court and had admitted to interim bail. Learned counsel for the petitioner has also placed on record the certified copy of the order dated 14.08.2023, passed by Mr. Amrinder Pal Singh, Additional Sessions Judge, Ludhiana, which is taken on record.

3. In view of the statement made by learned counsel for the petitioner, the interim order dated 11.08.2023, passed by this Court is made absolute. The petitioner is directed to be released on bail to the satisfaction of the trial

Court/Duty Magistrate, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438 (2) of the Cr.P.C. The petitioner shall continue to appear before the trial Court on each and every date of hearing and shall not absent during the course of proceedings without prior permission of the Court.
