VIKAS BAHL, J. (ORAL)

1. This writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of an appropriate writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to open the seal of Shop No.1565/1 under name and style of Popular Meat Shop, Triveni Road, Ambala City, District Ambala and to allow the petitioner to run the same till the time a specified area is earmarked and provided for running meat shops in the city.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that in pursuance of the order dated 16.07.2019 passed by Coordinate Bench of this Court, the shop in question of the petitioner has been de-sealed and has, thus, submitted that the present writ petition has been rendered

infructuous, but in case, the respondent authorities are to take any action against the premises of the petitioner, a show cause notice be issued to the petitioner and he be permitted to file a reply and any further order be passed after taking into consideration the said reply filed by the petitioner.

2. Learned State counsel appearing for respondent No.1 has submitted that respondent No.1 has no objection to the said course of action.

3. Keeping in view the above-said facts and circumstances, the present writ petition is disposed of, as having been rendered infructuous.

4. In case, the respondent authorities wish to take any further action against the premises of the petitioner, then, a show cause notice be issued to the petitioner and an opportunity to file reply be also given and in case the said reply is filed, then, further proceeding/order be passed after taking into consideration the said reply.
