Petitioners have approached this Court praying for issuance of directions to the official respondents not to harass the petitioner at the instance of private respondent with further directions to look into the matter and conduct fair investigation of the FIR No.18 dated 16.03.2022, under Sections 336, 427, 506, 148, 149 of IPC and Sections 25, 27 of Arms Act, registered at Police Station Hathur, District Ludhiana Rural.

It has been contended by counsel for the petitioners that the present FIR has been registered on 16.03.2022 and till date, there is no progress in the investigation and the same is being delayed on one pretext or the other by the investigating agency.

IO ASI Sulakhan Singh is present in person in the Court and he has apprised the Court that the case is under investigation and the same would be concluded within a month.

In view of the submissions made by learned State counsel and the investigating officer present in the Court, the present petition is disposed of with direction to the State to conclude the investigation within a month from today as submitted before this Court. The parties would be at liberty to pursue their remedies as available to them in accordance with law.
