In the instant petition, petitioner seeks for quashing of license No.4 dated 10.04.2023 and license No. 5 dated 19.05.2023, (Annexures P-9 and P-10) granted to M/s Jagshaan Enterprises (Respondent No.6) by respondent No. 3 being in gross violation of Rule 7(c) of Punjab Intoxicants License and Sales Order, 1956 as partners of M/s Jagshaan Enterprises are/were defaulters of the Excise Department, Punjab.

Upon instructions, learned State counsel has informed the Court that the petitioner has not participated in the process of issuance of licenses for the Excise Policy, 2022-23. Respondent No.6 M/s Jagshaan Enterprises is not the defaulter and respondent No.7 Balwant Rai was the surety in the other cases, where company is in default.

Since, in the present case, respondent No. 6 to whom license No. 04 dated 10.04.2023 and license No.05 dated 19.05.2023

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(Annexures P-9 and P-10) had been given this year, has never been a defaulter as a licensee and petitioner has not participated in the process of allotment of license, this writ petition is dismissed in limini.
