Instant writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing respondent No.2 to issue a “No Objection Certificate” (NOC) to the petitioner for appearing for interview on 19.11.2018, Annexure P-5, for the post of Senior Resident in Department of General Surgery

Upon instructions received from Sh. Gaurav Sharma, Deputy Superintendent, Director General, Health Services, Haryana, Sector-6, Panchkula, State counsel submits that NOC has been issued to all the three petitioners, even though, writ petition qua petitioner No.2 has been withdrawn. He submits that after completing the Senior Residency, all the three petitioners have rejoined the services with the Government. He submits that the petition has become infructuous.
