Reply by way of an affidavit of Rajat Gulia HPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Radaur, (Yamuna Nagar) has been filed by learned State counsel on behalf of respondents No. 1 to 3 and same is taken on record.

Registry is directed to tag the same at appropriate place.

While referring to the statements of both the petitioners dated 04.10.2022, which are annexed with the reply as Annexure R-1 and R-2, learned State counsel submits that there is no threat perception to both petitioners and in that regard already both the petitioners have given their statements to the police.

Said statements of petitioner No. 1-Rishabh Kataria and petitioner No. 2-Sakshi, dated 04.10.2022, recorded by SI Raj Pal, Police Station Radaur are reproduced here below:-

Statement of petitioner No. 1-Rishabh Kataria (Annexure R-1)

“Statement of Rishabh s/o Sh. Bhagwat Dayal

resident of House No. 736/9, Near Arya Samaj Mandir, College Road, Radaur, Police station Radaur, District Yamuna Nagar and age about 26, Mobile No. 9996804800

Stated that I am resident of above mentioned address and doing private job. My date of birth is 20-12-1996. After performing marriage on 20-12-1996 with Sakshi d/o Sh. Devraj resident of House No. 1403, Sec-3, Kurukshetra, we had taken protection. I and Sakshi both are major. Age of Sakshi is about 24 years and now we are residing as husband and wife at above mentioned address in Radaur. We have performed love marriage as per our wish and we both are happy with this marriage. Now we have no threat from anyone not from the parents of Sakshi. We do not want any protection. Statement got recorded, heard and admitted it as correct.”

Statement of petitioner No. 2-Sakshi (Annexure R-2)

“Statement of Sakshi d/o Sh. Dev Raj wife of Rishabh resident of House No. 736, Ward No. 9, Near Arya Samaj Mandir, College Road, Radaur, Police station Radaur, District Yamuna Nagar and age about 24 years, Mobile No. 9996804800

Stated that I am resident of above mentioned address and doing household work. My age is 24 years. I am major and I know my good and bad very well. I have performed love marriage with Rishabh s/o

Sh. Bhagwat Dayal resident of Arya Samaj Mandir, Radaur as per my wish and will without any pressure. I am very happy with this marriage and now we are residing as husband and wife at Radaur. I have no threat from anyone neither I have any threat from my father Devraj or my mother Sunita Rani. We have no need of any police protection. Statement got recorded, heard and admitted it as correct.”

Mr. Tarun Sharma, Advocate, appears and files his vakalatnama on behalf of respondents No. 5 and 6 and same is taken on record. Registry is directed to tag the same at appropriate place. He submits that he has instructions from respondents No. 5 and 6 that they have no objection to the relations of both the petitioners and would never cause any hindrance to their day to day life.

Faced with the situation, counsel for the petitioner does not want to press the present petition.

Present petition stands disposed of being not pressed, at this stage.
