The petitioner alleges violation of the order dated 05.10.2018, vide which writ petition filed by the petitioner challenging the order initiating departmental proceedings was allowed and suspension order and charge sheet as well as subsequent proceedings were set aside, however, it is observed that the respondents are free to issue fresh show cause notice to the petitioner as per rules and take appropriate action, as per law.

Reply by way of affidavit of Chairman-cum-Managing Director, Punjab State Power Corporation Ltd., Patiala, is on record, according to

which, the respondent has withdrawn the charge sheet as well as suspension order in compliance of the aforesaid order. It is further stated that after 05.10.2018, dues of the petitioner were released and an amount of Rs.91,068/- is paid on 06.08.2020 with a communication to him. It is also stated that 22 days salary amounting to Rs.22,336/- and other arrears, as stoppage of increments and annual increment amounting to Rs.3,06,459/-, after deducting the income tax, is also paid to the petitioner.

In view of the above, this contempt petition does not survive.

Accordingly, present petition is dismissed.
