Instant petition has been filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari for quashing order dated 02.05.2018, Annexure P-6, by which the service of the petitioner has been terminated.

In view of the preliminary submissions in the written statement filed by official respondents, counsel for the petitioner seeks and is granted permission to withdraw the writ petition with liberty to avail the remedy of appeal before the Additional Deputy Commissioner, Hisar.
