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**SANDEEP MOUDGIL, J. (ORAL)**

The jurisdiction of this Court under Section 439 Cr.P.C. has been invoked for the grant of regular bail to the petitioner in FIR No. 218, dated 11.12.2021, under Section 21 of NDPS Act, registered at Police Station STF, Wing, Ludhiana Range, Punjab.

In compliance of order dated 21.11.2022, a short reply dated 09.01.2023 filed by way of an affidavit of Mr. Shivraj Singh Nandgarh, PPS, Superintendent Central Jail, Ludhiana along-with Annexure R-1 by learned State counsel, is taken on record.

It is stated in the affidavit that the petitioner is a patient of Diabetes Mellitus-II, Hypertension with Prostatomegaly and is regularly taking treatment for the above-said ailment from the Jail Hospital.

From perusal of Annexure R-1, it is abundantly clear that the

petitioner was referred to Civil Hospital, Ludhiana on multiple times for medicine, surgical, eye and ENT consultations and examination. He was referred for Eye Specialist opinion and Psychiatric opinion on 23.05.2022. Thereafter, he was referred to ENT specialist for opinion on 26.05.2022 for thyroid test, investigation and FNAC of thyroid region.

It is also mentioned in the reply that the petitioner was again sent to Civil Hospital Ludhiana on 23.06.2022 for ultra sound of neck region and diagnosed with right thyroid nodule and was also examined by eye specialist of Civil Hospital Ludhiana and was diagnosed with early cataract. Thereafter, he was sent for follow up on 08.07.2022 for ENT consultation and treatment was advised after consultation and also advised repeat thyroid function test. He was referred to follow up in Eye OPD on 06.08.2022, 13.09.2022 and 29.10.2022 and was treated accordingly.

As per the medical advise, it is evident that the petitioner is required for follow up in ENT, Surgery and Eye OPD and he was taken to the hospital accordingly. It is also clear from the affidavit that the petitioner is being given best medical facility under the supervision of Senior Medical Officer, Central Jail, Ludhiana.

In the light of above, this Court does not find any reason to release the petitioner on regular bail on the ground of his ailment. Accordingly, the present petition is dismissed.
