AVNEESH JHINGAN, J (Oral):

1. The present petition has been filed aggrieved of order dated 12th July, 2023, whereby application filed by the petitioner under Section 91 Cr.P.C. read with Section 208 Cr.P.C. to supply the documents was rejected.

2. The grievance is that in view of the Supreme Court decision in ***Criminal Trials Guidelines Regarding Inadequacies and Deficiencies, in Re. Vs. State of Andhra Pradesh & Others, 2021 (10) SCC 598***, the list of the documents under Section 91 was not supplied.

3. Learned counsel for the respondent-CBI appearing on advance notice relying upon the reply filed to the application submits that CBI is ready to provide the list of documents not relied in the trial within ten days from today.

4. In view of the statement made by learned counsel for the respondent-CBI, no further directions are called for, the petition is disposed of.

5. Since the main case has been disposed of, pending application if any is rendered infructuous.
