After arguing for some time, learned counsel for the petitioners prays that the petitioners be allowed to withdraw this petition with liberty to approach the respondent-Union of India for the redressal of their grievance that after shifting of the programme from operations of Child helpline to Mission Vatsalya, appropriate direction be issued that the employees, who are already working under the earlier Scheme, should also be adjusted against the new Scheme by passing an appropriate direction.

At this stage, learned counsel for the respondent-UOI submits that in case, any representation is received from the petitioners

raising any grievance, the same will be considered in accordance with law and an appropriate speaking order will be passed within a period of four weeks from the receipt of any such representation and in case, the petitioners are found entitled for any relief, the same will also be extended to them.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that keeping in view the said statement of learned counsel for the respondent-UOI, the present petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed, at this stage.

Petition is disposed of with liberty as prayed for.
