The petitioner alleges violation of the order dated 11.05.2022 passed in CRWP-4466-2022, vide which without going into merits of the case, criminal writ petition was disposed of with a direction to the respondents to decide the representation dated 05.05.2022.

Short reply by way of affidavit of SSP, Amritsar Rural, filed in the Court today, is taken on record. As per this affidavit, the petitioner was directed to join the investigation. Thereafter, as many as 09 persons were joined the investigation by DSP Headquarters, Amritsar Rural, who conducted the detailed inquiry. It is further stated that marriage of Gurmukh Singh son of the petitioner-Ajaib Singh was solemnized with one Sukhchain Kaur and it was

second marriage of Sukhchain Kaur, as she has taken divorce from her previous husband. It is also stated that out of the present wedlock, a boy namely Manraj Singh was born, however, later on, they had a matrimonial dispute and the parties started giving complaints against each other. It is next stated that on conclusion of the inquiry, it is held that the petitioner has given many applications against govt. officials without any proof and primarily, it is a matrimonial dispute between son and daughter-in-law of the petitioner.

In view of the above, present petition is rendered as infructuous.
