The present petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking writ in the nature of certiorari for setting aside the order dated 19.11.2020 (Annexure P-8) passed by respondent No.2 with a further prayer for initiating proceedings under Section 51(3) of Haryana Panchayati Raj Act, against respondent No.4.

2. Learned State counsel has pointed out that in the present case, the tenure of respondent No.4 has lapsed and thus, the present petition has been rendered infructuous.
