The present petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for the grant of regular bail in FIR No.54 dated 22.05.2019 registered Sections 15, 25 and 29 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985 and Section 473 IPC at Police Station Hathur, District Ludhiana.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he does not press the present petition on its merits and would be satisfied if the same is disposed of with a direction to the trial court to finally dispose of the petitioner's trial expeditiously.

Learned State counsel has no objection if the above alternate prayer made on behalf of the petitioner is accepted.

Since every under-trial has a right to a speedy trial and because the State has no objection to the acceptance of the afore alternate prayer made on behalf of the petitioner as also because of long incarceration of the petitioner, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the trial court to finally dispose of the petitioner's trial within six months from the next date fixed before it in accordance with law.
