This is an application for placing on record the statements of witnesses PW1, PW2 and PW3 as Annexure P-10.

Application is allowed subject to all just exceptions and Annexure P-10 is taken on record.

CRM-M-41983-2022

This is a petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. seeking grant of regular bail in case FIR No.70 dated 06.08.2020, registered under Sections 376, 376-D and 452 IPC at Women Police Station Manesar, District Gurugram.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that petitioner is in custody since 18.07.2022, and material witnesses of the prosecution, i.e., eye

witness/father-in-law, the victim/prosecutrix and her husband have already been examined, and have not supported the prosecution.

Learned State counsel, upon instructions from LSI Lalli Devi, opposes the grant of bail to the petitioner, stating that trial is going on, and seventeen out of thirty five witnesses have already been examined. He, however, does not dispute the submissions made by learned counsel for the petitioner.

In this background, keeping in view the fact that conclusion of the trial will take long time and material witnesses already stand examined, this Court deems it appropriate to grant regular bail to the petitioner on his furnishing bail/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.

Ordered accordingly.

Petition stands allowed.
