1. This review application has been filed to seek recall of the detailed judgment passed on 10.07.2023, while disposing of the batch of connected writ petitions and the contempt petitions.

2. The learned senior counsel representing the review-applicants-petitioners has been heard at length. He has pointed out that in paragraph 8 and 54 of the judgment, there is a factual error as the posts of Physical Training Instructors (hereinafter referred to as 'PTI') is still available in the schools. He further submits that the State has also wrongly stated that against the total 849 posts advertised, 1137 PTI has already been appointed.

3. On the other hand, the learned counsel representing the State of Punjab submits that after the year 2018, there is no post of PTI available in Secondary as well as Senior Secondary Schools. It is available only in elementary schools, which is meant for students from Class Ist to Class 5th. He further submits that the recruitment notice issued in the year 2006 was for Secondary Education but from 2018, the aforesaid posts ceased to exist.

4. This court has considered the submissions of the learned counsel representing the parties.

5. In fact, the conclusion has been drawn by this Court after taking note of the fact that the recruitment notice was issued in the year 2006 and the entire selection was embroiled in tsunami of litigation. There were at least 4 to 5 rounds of litigation under various grounds at different points of time. This matter remained pending for nearly 16 years. After a passage of 16 years, it was not considered appropriate to issue directions to the State to issue appointment letters.

6. Keeping in view the aforesaid facts and discussion, no ground is made out to review the order dated 10.07.2023.

7. Dismissed.
