1. The present petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. praying for quashing the complaint No.19/07/Punjab/2021/ESDW dated 24.04.2021 (Annexure P-5), Mohan Lal Viridi vs. Neetu Rani and others.

2. Learned counsel for the complainant-respondent No.10 has produced a copy of the settlement dated 04.05.2023 as per which the second party i.e. the petitioner and others will pay a sum of Rs.15 lacs to the 1st party in full and final settlement of all grievances, and as mentioned in para 8 (i) of the settlement, the 1st party will not pursue and initiate any civil or criminal litigation against the second party in any manner. Learned counsel for the complainant-respondent No.10 along with complainant-Mohan Lal Viridi who appeared in person made a statement that the complaint (Annexure P-5) filed by him before the National Commission for Scheduled Castes, whereby a direction was given to the Deputy Commissioner, Jalandhar to enquire into the matter will itself be withdrawn and he shall not pursue any civil or criminal proceedings as has been agreed between the parties.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner has handed over a cheque No.056160 dated 01.05.2023 for an amount of Rs.15 lakhs to the learned counsel for respondent No.10, which has been handed over to complainant-Mohan Lal Viridi, in Court duly identified by his counsel and his aadhar card has been produced, which is taken on record as Mark-A along with the photocopy of the cheque as Mark-B.

4. In view of the aforesaid, the present petition stands disposed of in view of the settlement dated 04.05.2023.
