**PANKAJ JAIN, J. (Oral)**

Counsel representing the petitioner submits that so far as the principal relief prayed for in the present writ petition is concerned, the same shall stands released and further disbursed to the employees within 30 days from the receipt thereof. However, the employees have agitated their claim before the Educational Tribunal qua interest on the delayed payment wherein the petitioner has already been impleaded as party. He prays for liberty to raise all pleas to him before the Tribunal, though admits that so far as the present writ is concerned, the same has been rendered infructuous.
