The petitioner seeks grant of anticipatory bail under Section 438 Cr.P.C in case bearing FIR No.54 dated 23.05.2023 registered under Sections 420, 465, 468, 471, 506, 120-B, 447, 511 IPC and Section 467 IPC added later on at Police Station Anaj Mandi, Patiala.

The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of the order dated 06.10.2023, the petitioner has joined the investigation to the entire satisfaction of the Investigating Officer.

The learned State counsel on instructions admits the aforesaid fact and submits that the petitioner is no more required for further investigation in the case.

In view of aforesaid factual position, the interim order dated 06.10.2023 is made absolute. However, the petitioner shall keep on joining the investigation as and when required to do so and he shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

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However, it is made clear that if any attempt is made by the petitioner and/or their relatives/friends/associates to threaten the complainant party, the State/complainant is at liberty to file an application for cancellation of bail granted vide this order.

The petition stands disposed of.
