1. This is an application filed under Section 151 of CPC for withdrawal of the main case as the same has been rendered infructuous.
2. Learned counsel for the applicant/petitioner has submitted that the main case is now listed for 10.10.2023 and he wishes to withdraw the same as the same has been rendered infructuous and thus, prays for allowing of the application and for the preponement of the main case from 10.10.2023 to today itself.
3. On the other hand, learned State Counsel has submitted that she has no objection in case the present application is allowed and the date of

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the present Civil Writ Petition has been rendered infructuous and the same may kindly be disposed of as such.

3. In view of the abovesaid statement made by learned counsel for the petitioner, the present Civil Writ Petition is disposed of as having been rendered infructuous.
