Petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in the criminal complaint No.CIS-SC-134 of 2018 dated 06.12.2018, under Sections 323/506 IPC and Section 3 of Scheduled Castes & Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Act, 1989, titled as “Suman Devi Versus Anju and another” registered at Police Station Nangal Chaudhary, District Mahendergarh

On a query, learned counsel for the petitioner fairly contends that no application under Section 438 Cr.P.C was moved before the Court of Sessions before approaching this Court. Accordingly, he seeks to withdraw the present petition with liberty to approach the Court of Sessions for anticipatory bail as per the provisions of Section 438 Cr.P.C and has also restricted his prayer only to the extent that interim protection granted to the petitioner in terms of order dated 19.09.2022 may be extended in a meanwhile.

Dismissed as withdrawn. However, it is directed that in the event, the petitioner moves an application under Section 438 Cr.P.C before the Court of Sessions within two weeks, the Interim protection granted in terms of order

dated 19.09.2022 will enure till disposal of the said application, and also for a period of two weeks thereafter in the event, the application is dismissed by the concerned Court.
