This is a Civil Writ Petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing respondent Nos.2 to 4 to issue School Leaving Certificate to the niece of the petitioner.

On 17.01.2023, this Court had passed the following order:-

“Learned counsel for respondent No.5 has submitted that in case the girl child or her parents move an application in writing to respondent No.5 for the copy of school leaving certificate, then respondent No.5 would issue the same.

Adjourned to 27.01.2023.

To be taken up 3.00 PM.”

Learned counsel for respondent No.5 has submitted that in spite

of the last order, neither the girl child, nor her parents had moved an application in writing but only to show their bona fide, they have got the School Leaving Certificate in the Court which has been handed over to the learned counsel for the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has reiterated the fact that the School Leaving Certificate has been handed over to him by learned counsel for respondent No.5 in the Court today and undertakes to give the same to the girl child and her parents. It is further submitted that in view of the same, the present Civil Writ Petition has been rendered infructuous.

Keeping in view the abovesaid facts and circumstances, the present Civil Writ Petition is disposed of as having been rendered infructuous.

The petitioner would be bound by his undertaking to give the said School Leaving Certificate to the girl child and her parents.
