Present second petition has been filed for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.03, dated 12.01.2023, under Sections 365, 323, 342, 506, 34, 120-B of IPC and Section 3 of Prevention of Damage to Public Property Act and Enhanced Offence under Section 379-B of IPC vide Rapat No.19 dated 13.01.2023, registered at Police Station Bahav Wala, District Fazilka.

Status report dated 06.10.2023 by way of an affidavit of Avtar Singh, PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police (Rural), Abohar, District Fazilka on behalf of the respondent has been filed by learned State counsel today in the Court and the same is taken on record.

By virtue of the order dated 21.08.2023, while granting interim protection, the petitioner was directed to join investigation. It has been contended by learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner has

joined the investigation and fully cooperated and thus, the interim order may kindly be made absolute.
