1. The petitioner through instant petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India is seeking direction to respondents to re-issue the passport of the petitioner.

2. Learned counsels for the parties are *ad idem* that FIR No.46 dated 27.03.2018 under Sections 307, 353, 186, 332, 506 & 34 of IPC registered at Police Station Makhu, District Ferozepur is pending against the petitioner and in view of Notification No.570 dated 25.08.1993 (Annexure P-6), the petitioner is supposed to approach the Trial Court.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner seeks permission to withdraw the present petition with liberty to approach the Trial Court in terms of notification dated 25.08.1993.

4. Dismissed as withdrawn with aforesaid liberty.

5. If the petitioner moves an application before the Trial Court in terms of the aforesaid notification, the Trial Court is requested to pass an appropriate order expeditiously.
