Instant petition has been filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to pay the petitioners minimum of the pay scale of the posts being held by them i.e. equal pay for equal work, as is being paid to the regular employees by the respondents holding the same posts, as are being held by the petitioners in view of the judgment rendered by the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in case titled as ***State of Punjab Versus Jagjit Singh and others 2016 (4) SCT 641.***

State counsel has placed on record a copy of office order dated 24.04.2019, to submit that the petitioners have been granted minimum of

the pay-scale i.e. Rs.16,900/- in terms of judgment passed by the Supreme Court in *State of Punjab Versus Jagjit Singh* (supra). He has specific instructions to state that the monetary benefit has been paid to the petitioners w.e.f. 03.11.2017.

In view of above, counsel for the petitioner submits that the petition has become infructuous.

Dismissed as having been rendered infructuous.
