The instant application has been filed under Order 1 Rule
10 read with Section 151 of the Code of Civil Procedure, 1908 for
impleading the complainant as respondent No.12.

Notice in the application had been issued on 09.12.2022, however, no reply has been filed till date.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioners has no objection to the aforesaid prayer being granted.

Accordingly, the present application is allowed.

Complainant Saurabh Yadav is impleaded as respondent No.12.

Amended Memo of Parties is taken on record.

The Registry is directed to tag the same at appropriate place.

Main case

The instant writ petition has been filed for seeking issuance of directions to the respondents to defreeze the accounts maintained by the petitioners and family members including minor children that have been illegally freezed.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Gurpreet Singh, Police Station, Sohana, S.A.S. Nagar, Mohali, submits that the order of freezing has been passed with respect to total sixteen (16) accounts and that letters have already been issued to the concerned Banks to defreeze thirteen (13) Accounts and a separate communication for remaining three (03) Accounts has also been sent. It is thus contended that there is no subsisting cause of action as the directions have already been issued to defreeze the accounts of the petitioners.

In view of the aforesaid statement made by the learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Gurpreet Singh, Police Station, Sohana, S.A.S. Nagar, Mohali, the present petition is disposed of as having been rendered infructuous.

All other pending applications shall also stand disposed of accordingly.
