MANJARI NEHRU KAUL, J. (ORAL)

1. The petitioner is seeking the concession of anticipatory bail under Section 438 of the Cr.P.C. in case FIR No.58 dated 10.06.2023 under Sections 420/406 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, registered at Police Station Ghall Khurd, Ferozepur.

2. On 24.08.2023, learned counsel for the petitioner has made following submissions:-

“Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is willing to hand over a sum of ₹1 lakh which was allegedly transferred in his account by the complainant. He undertakes to get a demand draft in the sum of ₹1 lakh on the next date of hearing for handing over the same to learned counsel for the complainant.”

3. Thereafter, on 01.09.2023 the petitioner was granted interim bail and had been asked to join investigation.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of order dated 01.09.2023, the petitioner has joined

investigation and cooperated with the investigating agency.

4. Learned State counsel, on instructions from HC Harjinder Singh, does not dispute the factum of the petitioner having joined investigation and cooperated with the investigating agency. He, on further instructions, submits that the petitioner is not required for further investigation much less for his custodial interrogation.

5. In view of the above, the petition is allowed and interim order dated 01.09.2023, is made absolute subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
