VIKAS BAHL, J.(ORAL)

1. This is a civil writ petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the official respondents to take action against the private respondents for construction of restaurant and bar on the residential plot.

2. Learned counsel for respondent no.1-Municipal Corporation, on instructions from the Assistant Town Planner, Zone D, has submitted that in the present case, on 09.01.2019 the property belonging to the private respondent was sealed and an inspection has recently been done as per which the premises are lying in dilapidated condition and there is no activity in the same. It is further submitted that no person has come to get

the order of sealing.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that in view of the above statement of learned counsel for respondent no.1, the present petition be disposed of as having been rendered infructuous.
4. In view of the above, the present petition is disposed of as having been rendered infructuous, at this stage.
5. It is made clear that it would be open to the respondent authorities to pass any order, in accordance with law.
6. Pending miscellaneous application, if any, shall stand disposed of in view of the abovesaid order.
