Prayer in the present petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in a case bearing FIR No.200 dated 31.08.2021 under Sections 20/27A of the NDPS Act, 1985 registered at Police Station Garhi, District Jind.

Vide order dated 03.11.2021 while granting interim protection, the petitioner was directed to join investigation.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that pursuant to order dated 03.11.2021 petitioner has joined the investigation and as such his interim bail may be made absolute. The learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Kuldeep Singh has affirmed the fact that the petitioner has joined the investigation and his further investigation in the present case is not required.

In view of the above, interim order dated 03.11.2021 is made absolute subject to compliance of conditions as envisaged under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.

The present petition stands disposed off.
