This petition has been filed under Section 482 of the Cr.P.C for quashing of case/FIR No.0014 dated 05.04.2019 under Section 420, 465, 467, 468, 471 of IPC, 1860 registered at Police Station Nandgarh, District Bathinda (Annexure P-1).

On 9-02.2022 the following order was passed:-

As per the report, which has come from the District and Sessions Judge, Bathinda, all the victims are not party to the compromise in question. As per the report of the Court below, there are three victims in the FIR namely, Sukhjit Kaur, Jagsir Singh and Vakil Singh and the compromise between the parties on the basis of which, quashing of FIR in question is sought, is only with one victim namely, Sukhjit Kaur.

As no one has joined the virtual proceedings on behalf of the petitioner, in the interest of justice, adjourned to 20.04.2022.

It is made clear that in case, on the adjourned date, no one appears on behalf of the petitioner, appropriate order on the prayer of the petitioner as raised in the present petition, will be passed.

The petitioner neither appeared on 09.02.2022 nor is present today. Therefore, in view of the matter, since two other victims namely Jagsir Singh and Vakil Singh have neither been impleaded in this petition nor there is any compromise of the petitioner with them, therefore, the FIR in question cannot be quashed on the basis of compromise as the same is not the valid compromise.

Disposed of, accordingly.
