SANJIV BERRY, J.

By way of present petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, the petitioner, namely Mohinder Singh, seeks grant of extension in parole w.e.f. 27.08.2023, on the date, he is supposed to surrender before the jail authorities on the expiry of his existing parole.

2. It is, *inter alia*, contended by learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner had been suffering from brain tumor and is undergoing treatment from PGIMER, Chandigarh. He has further contended that in pursuance to the parole granted vide order dated 01.07.2023 (Annexure P-3) by Superintendent, Open Agricultural Jail, Nabha, the petitioner has to surrender on 27.08.2023.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner has further contended that the petitioner has already moved a representation dated 02.08.2023, (Annexure P-4), to the Superintendent, Open Jail, Nabha, but till date no action has been taken thereon. Hence, the present petition.

4. On the asking of the Court, Ms. Swati Batra, DAG, Punjab, has put in appearance on behalf of the respondents.

5. After hearing the respective submissions and keeping in view the averments made in the petition, whereby the petitioner is seeking extension of parole on medical grounds and has already moved a representation dated 02.08.2023 (Annexure P-4), at this stage, without commenting on the merits of the case, the petition is disposed of with the direction to respondent No. 2-The Superintendent, Open Air Jail, Nabha, to consider the representation dated 02.08.2023 (Annexure P-4), specifically considering the medical condition of the petitioner, within 07 days from today, in accordance with law.

Decision so taken be conveyed to the petitioner.
