Mr. Rawal further submits that apart from the aforesaid payments, further payment of Rs.19,235/- also stands paid on account of arrears of promotional increments which is pursuant to Memo No. 5982 dated 27.07.2022 which has been placed on record as Annexure R-12.

Ms. Sareen, however, submits that once respondents themselves admitted that the payments have been made with inordinate delay as the petitioner retired way back on 31.07.2012, the said amounts must bear interest as the same have been wrongly withheld by the Corporation.

In view of the above, respondents are further directed to pay an interest of 6% per annum for the period commencing from 01.11.2012 till the date of actual realization. However, at the same time liberty is granted to the petitioner to move an appropriate application for revival of the present writ petition in case he still feels that his grievance as raised in the petition still survives.

5. Disposed off, accordingly.
