Present writ petition has been filed for quashing the order dated 09.06.2023 (Annexure P-6) passed by respondent No.6 by illegal appointing Administrator at the behest of private respondents, who in connivance with respondents No.2 and 3 got passed the aforesaid order, which is illegal, arbitrary and deserves to be set aside. Further prayer has been made for staying the appointment of Administrator for which further extension will be initiated by official respondents in connivance with private respondents as it amounts to an abuse of process of law and for directing respondents No.1 and 2 to take a legal action against respondents No.3 to 13, who are hand in gloves with each others & have misappropriated Panchayat funds by illegally appointing the Administrator.

Mr. M. S. Virk, Advocate has appeared for Dr. Puneet Kaur Sekhon, Advocate by filing memorandum of appearance on behalf of respondents No.7 to 12 today in the Court and the same is taken on record.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from Mr. Darshan Singh, Panchayat Officer, has submitted before this Court that tenure of the Administrator has already expired on 12.10.2023 and at present, the Administrator is no more on the post, thus, the present petition is rendered infructuous and the same may be disposed of as such.

In view of the submissions made by learned counsel for the State, the present petition is disposed of as having been rendered infructuous.
