Disposed of with a direction to the learned executing court concerned to, after drawing an objective satisfaction with respect to the encroachment(s), if any, made on the petition land(s), at the instance of the private respondents concerned, and, after recording an objective satisfaction with regard to the objections, if any, which are raised by the private respondents concerned, qua the validity of the demarcation report concerned, to thereafter proceed to draw fresh warrants of possession in respect of the petition property. Such an objective satisfaction be recorded, but, positively within a period of three months from today. If the learned Collector concerned, assigns credence to the demarcation report concerned, thereupon, he shall forthwith proceed to draw fresh warrants of possession, and, shall also ensure the completest, and, efficacious execution thereof, in respect of the petition property.
