1. The petitioner is seeking quashing of order dated 28.07.2023 (Annexure P-4) passed by the learned Trial Court whereby non-bailable warrants have been issued against him in a complaint filed under Section 138 of the NI Act bearing No.NACT/5567/2021 dated 14.07.2021 titled as 'Darshan Singh Kaushish Vs. Jagtar Singh'.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner at the outset submits that the petitioner is willing and ready to appear, and surrender before the Trial Court. Hence, in the aforementioned facts and circumstances, the petitioner be protected till his appearance before the Trial Court and with directions to the Trial Court that his bail application, which he would be filing on his surrender, be decided expeditiously.

3. In view of the limited prayer made by the learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant petition is disposed of with directions to the petitioner to appear and surrender before the Trial Court within 07 days from today. Till then, no coercive steps be taken against the petitioner.

4. It is made clear that in case, the petitioner fails to surrender before the Trial Court within 07 days from today, this order shall be of no avail to him. In case, on appearance and surrender, the petitioner moves an application for bail before the Trial Court, the same shall be decided expeditiously, by the Trial Court in accordance with law.
