AVNEESH JHINGAN, J (Oral):

1. The present petition has been filed for issuance of directions to make the proceedings in FIR No. RCCHQ2016A0012, dated 27th May, 2016, under Sections 420, 468, 471, 120-B of IPC and Section 13(1)(d) of Prevention of Corruption Act, 1988, registered at Police Station CBI/ACB/CHG-2017.

2. It is undisputed fact that CBI has submitted cancellation report in 2019 and petitioner filed a protest petition which is pending before the Court concerned.

3. In view of the above circumstances, no directions are required to be issued to the CBI, no case is made out for interference.

4. The petition is dismissed.

5. However, petitioner would be at liberty to make a request for expeditious disposal of protest petition.

6. There is no doubt that in eventuality of the petitioner approaching the court concerned for expeditious disposal of the protest petition, the same would be considered in accordance with law.

7. Since the main case has been dismissed, pending application if any is rendered infructuous.
