Only direction given by the writ Court in CWP-9598-2017 on 13.11.2018 is to pay the interest @9% per annum on the delayed payment of retiral benefits, from the due date.

As per fresh compliance affidavit of District Education Officer (Secondary Education), Roopnagar, filed in the Court today, an amount of Rs.36,143/- is paid to the petitioner on account of interest on the delay payment. The details of the payments with regard to leave encashment and commutation of pension are also given in the affidavit.

In view of the above, present petition is rendered as infructuous.

Liberty is granted to the petitioner to avail the alternative remedy, in accordance with law.
