1. This Court vide order dated 28.08.2023 directed that the representation be examined *qua* the limited extent of alleged threat perception of the petitioner and in case it is found that there is a genuine threat to life and liberty then necessary steps warranted under the law be taken thereupon.

2. The petitioner has not been able to show any instance after order dated 18.05.2023 where her life and liberty has been put to threat at the same time there is no operative order of the Court. In view thereof, no case for contempt is made out.
