Present writ petition has been filed for quashing the impugned order dated 09.08.2016 (Annexure P-3) passed by respondent No.1 vide which the first appeal filed by the petitioner against the order dated 05.07.2016 (Annexure P-1) has been summarily dismissed in limine without perusing records and evidence and without affording effective opportunity of hearing and further for quashing the impugned order dated 05.07.2016 (Annexure P-1) as the same has been passed against the law and facts of the case. Further prayer has been made to direct respondent No.1 to rehear the matter and decide the appeal (Annexure P-2) filed by the petitioner after perusing the evidence and records of the case.

The petition is pending since 2017. Record will show that the petitioner was not represented by anyone on 24.04.2019. Thereafter on 22.03.2022, when the case came up for hearing, again no one appeared on behalf of the petitioner. Thereafter, there was no representation on behalf of the petitioner on 24.05.2022 and 16.01.2023. However, today the position is the same and an adjournment slip has been filed by learned counsel for the petitioner.

In view of the above, it is clear that the petitioner is not interested in arguing the matter and he is prolonging the proceedings. Hence, the written request for adjournment is rejected and the present petition is dismissed for non prosecution.
