The instant petition has been filed by the petitioners seeking appropriate directions to respondent No.2 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners and not to harass and humiliate the petitioners at the instance of private respondents.

On issuance of notice of motion, short reply by way of affidavit of Sh. Daljit Singh, P.P.S., Deputy Superintendent of Police, Garhshankar, District Hoshiarpur, has been filed on behalf of respondent No.1 and 2. In Para 6 and 7 of the status report, it has been averred as under:-

“6. The matter in dispute pertains to plot is of civil nature and the case for the same is already pending in the Hon’ble Court. Therefore, the SHO, P.S. Garhshankar considered to wait the decision of the Hon’ble Court in the matter and recommended to file the above said application of petitioner Sandeep Joshi and respondent Balwinder Chaudhary.

7. That it is submitted that the Police of P.S. Garhshankar verified that there is no danger to the life and liberty of the

petitioner at the hands of respondent No.4 to 6 as alleged by them in the present petition. However, the SHO, P.S. Garhshankar, District Hoshiarpur instructed the daily duty officers of Police Station Garhshankar and officials of PCR Unit Garhshankar to keep vigil upon the house of the petitioners to avoid any untoward incident.”

In view of the stand taken in the aforesaid short reply, learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the instant petition has been rendered infructuous.

Disposed of as having become infructuous.
