Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the writ petition was filed to challenge the interim order dated 18.08.2022 (Annexure P-4) passed by Central Government Industrial Tribunal-cum-Labour Court, Chandigarh, whereby the statutory requirement to maintain the appeal was altered by directing the respondent No.1 (appellant) to deposit only 20% of the assessed amount, instead of 75% in terms of Section 7 Q Employees' Provident Funds & provisions Act, 1952.

He further states that during the pendency of this writ petition, the appeal has already been decided by the Tribunal vide order dated 27.02.2023.

In view of the above, it is apparent that the impugned interim order dated 18.08.2022 stands merged in the final decision dated 27.02.2023 by the Tribunal, therefore, nothing survives for adjudication in this writ petition.

Dismissed as infructuous.
