Present petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case bearing FIR No.380 dated 03.06.2023, registered for offences punishable under Sections 323, 324, 34, 452 and 506 of IPC, 1860 (Sections 326, 307, 120-B, 201, 148 & 149 of IPC, 1860 and Section 25 of the Arms Act, 1959 added later on and Section 34 of IPC deleted later on), at Police Station Assandh, District Karnal.

2. Counsel for the petitioner submits that from the bare perusal of the allegations levelled in the FIR, it is clear that the petitioner was not present on the spot and has not been named in the present FIR. The only role attributed to the petitioner is that she was annoyed with the victims who happen to be her parents-in-law.

3. Challan already stands presented. Investigation is complete. Petitioner is behind bars for more than 02 months and 15 days.

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4. Learned counsel for the State does not dispute the aforesaid fact.
5. Consequently, the present petition is allowed. Without commenting on the merits of the case, the petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on her furnishing bail/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the Ld. Trial Court/Duty Magistrate, concerned.
6. Needless to say nothing recorded herein shall be construed to be an expression of an opinion on the merits of the case.
