RAVI SHANKER JHA, CHIEF JUSTICE (Oral)

In the wake of the issues raked up by the petitioner in the petition at hand, learned senior counsel for the respondent(s), who is present in Court, submits that authorities would issue a fresh show cause notice to the petitioner. And, after affording an opportunity to submit its response, the authorities would take a decision afresh in accordance with law. Thus, in the given situation, he submits that show cause notice dated

25.07.2023 (P-9), as well as the order dated 08.08.2023 (P-1), passed by the respondent – authorities, would be deemed to have been withdrawn.

In response, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in view of the statement made by learned senior counsel for the respondent(s), nothing substantive survives in the petition, and the same be disposed of as having been rendered infructuous.

Ordered accordingly.

Since the main petition has been disposed of, CM-13417-CWP-2023 also stands disposed of.
