Learned State counsel, on the instructions from SI Javed Ali from Police Station Matlauda, District Panipat, informs the Court that out of

the total twenty-two (22) witnesses, as cited by the prosecution in the list, fifteen (15) witnesses have already been examined before the trial Court whereas six (06) witnesses have been given up by the prosecution and thus, only one (01) witness is left to be examined and now, the case, as pending before the trial Court, is scheduled to be listed on 01.03.2023 for the above-said purpose.

At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks permission to withdraw the instant petition while submitting that the petitioner is behind the bars for more than four (04) years and therefore, the trial Court may be directed to decide the said case within some specific time frame.

Learned State counsel has no objection in the withdrawal of the present petition as well as to the afore-discussed submission as made by learned counsel for the petitioner.

Resultantly, the petition in hand is, hereby, dismissed for having been withdrawn with the direction to the concerned trial Court to conclude the trial proceedings and to decide the criminal case, pending before it, upto 30.04.2023.
