Learned counsel for the petitioner seeks permission to withdraw the instant petition while submitting that the same has become infructuous in view of the contents of para No.7 in the Status-Report, as filed on behalf of the respondent-State, to the effect that during the investigation in the criminal case arisen out of the FIR bearing No.0635 dated 23.08.2022 registered at Police Station Hansi City, District Hansi, under Section 346 IPC (wherein the offence under Section 6 of the POCSO Act, 2012 is stated to have been added later-on), the petitioner has been found to be innocent and the cancellation report has already been prepared in respect thereof.
