This appeal has been filed by the appellant-wife challenging judgment and decree dated 16.10.2019, passed by the learned Family Court, Ambala, whereby while dismissing petition under Section 13-B of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 (for short 'the Act') present appellant was directed to refund the sum of ₹8,50,000/- which had been handed over to her by the husband in terms of the settlement which had been arrived at between them for the reason that she withdrew her consent of divorce by mutual consent at the time of recording of statements at second motion.

2. Learned counsel for the parties submit that the matter has now again been amicably resolved between the parties. Petition under Section 13-B of the Act, filed by them has since been allowed on 25.05.2023. It is further submitted that the parties shall remain bound by the terms and conditions of the compromise. The entire amount due to the appellant has been received by her. She remains bound to withdraw all criminal/civil

litigation, which may have been initiated by her. Copy of order dated 25.05.2023, passed by the learned Family Court, Ambala, furnished in Court today is taken on record subject to just exceptions.

3. In this view of the matter, learned counsel for the appellant seeks to withdraw this appeal.

4. Appeal is accordingly dismissed as withdrawn.

5. Pending application(s), if any, stands disposed of.
