Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for issuance of directions to respondent No.2-Commissioner of Police, Ludhiana to take action in accordance with law on the complaint dated 13.04.2022 filed by the petitioner.

2. As per the order dated 18.08.2023, the matter was referred to the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court. The report of the mediator has been received which shows that the matter has been compromised between the parties and they have decided to part ways by way of filing a joint petition under Section 13-B of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955. The petitioner as well as respondent No.5 have further mutually agreed that if any complaint/case is pending before any Competent Court of law the same shall be withdrawn.

3. Status report by way of an affidavit of Sanjay Kumar, PPS, Assistant Commissioner of Police, CAW&C-Cell, Ludhiana has been filed on behalf of respondent-State, which is taken on record. It has been stated in the

status report that no action is required to be taken by the police on the said complaint and it is decided to consign the complaint moved by the petitioner to the record room.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that that present petition be disposed of as the matter has been compromised between the parties.
