SURESHWAR THAKUR, J. (ORAL)

1. Learned counsel for the petitioner seeks, and, is granted permission to withdraw the present petition.
2. Dismissed as withdrawn, but with liberty to institute a petition under Section 11 of The Haryana Village Common Lands (Regulation) Act, 1961, before the learned Collector concerned, who on receiving the said petition, shall within 4 months of its preferment before him, thus pass a lawful speaking decision thereon, but after hearing all affected persons concerned.
3. Consequently, if a declaratory decree is pronounced in favour of the present petitioner by the learned Collector concerned, thereupon it is permissible to the present petitioner to institute a suit for damages against the respondents concerned, as arising from any purported unlawful demolition of his house, as carried on the suit land, thus being made, at the instance of the respondents concerned.
