The jurisdiction of this Court has been preferred under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to enroll the services of the petitioners on the roll of Municipal Council, Yamuna Nagar or that of Haryana Kaushal Rozgar Nigam Limited as per instructions dated 21.09.2021 (Annexure P-13) and 14.04.2022 (Annexure P-14).

2. At the very outset, learned counsel for the petitioners submits that he would be satisfied in case a direction is issued to respondent No.3 to decide the representations dated 22.03.2023 (Annexure P-15 & P-16) respectively submitted by the petitioners, whereupon no action has been taken by the authorities so far, in a time bound manner, in accordance with law.

3. Notice of motion.

4. On the asking of the Court, Ms. Safia Gupta, A.A.G., Haryana accepts notice on behalf of the official respondents only at this stage.

5. Let sufficient number of copies of the complete paper-book be supplied to her, during the course of day.

6. Without commenting on merits of the case and considering the prayer

made by learned counsel for the petitioners, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondents No.3 and 5 to decide the representations dated 22.03.2023 (Annexure P-15 & P-16) respectively, as per policy, within a period of three months from the date of receipt of the certified copy of this order, in accordance with law and convey the decision to the petitioners within a week thereafter. In case of failure to do so, the officer responsible for the lapse would be liable to costs of Rs.20,000/- from his personal pocket, to be deposited with the Punjab and Haryana High Court Advocates Welfare Fund.
